The story is set in Stockholm and in Budapest, at the beginning of the 1940's. At a diplomatic conference in Stockholm, in the 1940's the Swedish Raoul Wallenberg is given the task by the president of the U.S.A. and the support organizations of refugees, to protect the Budapest Jews from deportation, which endangers them. He is offered diplomatic immunity. After considering it for a few minutes, Wallenberg decides to undertake the dangerous task.

At a Budapest railway station armed German soldiers push Jews into carriages, an officer checks the lists. Wallenberg wants to give Swedish citizenship to a Jew, but the officer shoots the Jew.

Wallenberg has a plan of equipping the Budapest Jews with Swedish passports. He invites the SS-Obersturmbannführer Eichmann for dinner, and tells him that the purpose of his being in Budapest is saving lives. Eichmann reminds Wallenberg that immunity is only an agreement. Wallenberg feels that he has no time.

Again at a Budapest railway station, Wallenberg distributes the employment certificates. A woman gives back her passport and goes to the concentration camp. Jews march into death. Eichmann has done his job. The war is over, the Soviet army invades Budapest. The diplomats assure Wallenberg that he will have a new mission to accomplish.

After the war the Soviet officers do not wish to give any information about Wallenberg's whereabouts. The prisoners of Gulag claim that they have seen the Wallenberg of the past, But the hero of their memories is only a reflection. In the meantime Eichmann is on his way to Jerusalem, where he must account for his actions in court. He is sentenced to death.

Finally we are in the Wallenberg circus. Raoul Wallenberg is praised as a guardian angel.

Wallenberg's uncle Jacob Wallenberg, speaks about his nephew. The president of the U.S.A., Ronald Reagan declares Wallenberg an honorary citizen of the United States.
